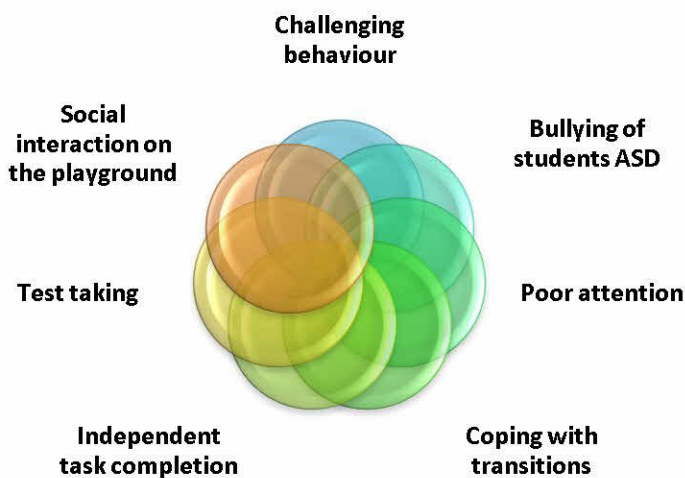


School Consults

Our goal when consulting with any school is to develop a collaborative approach to identifying and addressing the difficulties that students with Autism Spectrum Disorders and the staff that support them experience during the learning process. Our philosophy about students with ASD is that like all students, their learning needs and challenges are unique. No two students, teachers or schools are the same. Therefore recommendations for each student should reflect this diversity.

We can assist you to incorporate a behaviour-based approach into your classroom setting so that you can maximise the performance of your students with ASD and reduce the problematic issues that interfere with their ability to learn.



Specific services which we can offer include:

- Designing positive behaviour intervention plans
- Assisting with adapting teaching curriculum
- Developing and incorporating visuals into the classroom
- Identifying 'best-fit' teaching strategies that will work for your student with ASD
- Assist with any additional training or support for staff that would enhance their competence when working with students with ASD

Typically, school consults are conducted in the following way:

1. The student is observed in the classroom/on the playground to assess the nature of the issue
2. Further information is gathered from the relevant teaching faculty to give perspective to the observations or provide information where an actual observation is not possible
3. A written report is generated outlining specific recommendations that could be incorporated
4. Additional training for school staff to implement the recommendations can be provided if necessary
